POLICY: ACCESS, BEHAVIOUR AND CONTROL OF DOGS AT HOLLOWELL POCKET PARK

- 1) Members of the Public are permitted access to the Park at their own risk.
- 2) Persons attending the Park must not cause a nuisance to others within the Park or residents of households on Creaton Road, Hollowell, NN6 8RP,
- 3) The Daventry District Council Public Space Protection Order (PSPO) 'Obligations on Persons with **Dogs'** applies to all areas of the Park and requires:
- a) Fouling If a dog defecates at any time on land to which this order applies a person who is in charge of the dog at the time must remove the faeces from the land forthwith.
- b) Leads by Order A person in charge of a dog on land to which this order applies must comply with the direction given to him by an authorised officer of the Authority to put and keep the dog on a lead. An authorised officer may only give a direction under this order if such restraint is reasonably necessary to prevent a nuisance or behaviour by the dog that is likely to cause annoyance or disturbance to any other person, or to a bird or another animal.
- c) Exclusion A person in charge of a dog must not take it into or keep it within a fenced / enclosed children's play area and signed at its entrances as a 'dog exclusion area' (or words and / or symbols having like effect) which is designated and marked for children's play.*
- d) Means to Pick Up A person in charge of a dog on land to which this order applies must have with him an appropriate means to pick up dog faeces deposited by that dog.
- 4) Motorcycles are **NOT** permitted access to the Park.
- 5) Any person who acts in breach of these policy requirements will be required to leave the Park immediately and not allowed further access until the Parish Council has received assurance that no future breaches will occur
- 6) The Parish Council reserve the right to prohibit access to any person deemed to be in breach of these policy requirements.
