**Policy Re: Maintenance of 'the Jetty' [RoW CYP6], between Church Hill and
Guilsborough Hill, Hollowell**

- 1) The Public Right of Way (RoW) CY6 is the acknowledged responsibility of Northamptonshire County Council (NCC).
- 2) Maintenance of the RoW should be undertaken by the NCC RoW Team with reports of action required being registered via the Street Doctor system (Online - <https://fixmystreet.northamptonshire.gov.uk/>)
- 3) The Parish Council acknowledges the concerns raised by residents relating to the maintenance of the 'The Jetty' and has responded to those concerns by enquiring of residents, whose properties border the 'The Jetty', as to whether they are willing and able to assist in maintaining the boundary areas and surface of the footpath.
- 4) The Parish Council will consider requests to assist in the maintenance of 'the Jetty' and will make budget allocation for funding of a contractor to attend the area to clear vegetation and debris from the borders and pathway up to three times in any year.
This assistance will only be provided if the responses to reports to Street Doctor and the efforts of residents are not sufficient to maintain the RoW.
- 5) The maintenance to be provided by the Parish Council will be sufficient to allow pedestrians to walk along the RoW clear of overhanging branches, border vegetation and debris on the surface.
- 6) The general condition of The Jetty will be monitored by the Councillor with delegated responsibility for Liaison with NCC Rights of Way Team and reported to the Council if it is considered assistance should be provided. The Council will determine if assistance is to be provided.
- 7) Residents should report their concerns about The Jetty to the Clerk who will initiate a report to Street Doctor, if such action is confirmed by the Councillor with responsibility for Liaison with RoW Team.
